**VOTED K-12 Board 02-20K** Of the excess instructional time accumulated through built-in snow days by Conference elementary schools, three can be used as follows:

- a. Only one can be used during the first semester;
- b. Parent-teacher conferences;
- c. Teacher in-services other than the ones planned by the Conference of Education.

All other snow days not used for weather or as stated above are forfeited for that year.

### Tennessee Code 49-6-3004

(e) (1) A local board of education or private or church related school which exceeds the full six and one-half (6 1/2) hour daily for the full academic year shall be credited with such additional instructional time. The excess instructional time shall be accumulated in amounts up to but not exceeding thirteen (13) instructional days each year and applied toward meeting instructional time requirements missed due to dangerous or extreme weather conditions.

(2) Any unused accumulated days for excess instructional time shall not carry over to a school year other than the year in which such time was accumulated.
